Sci-fi obsessed synth pop band NZCA LINES have teamed up with designers **TAXONYM** and NYC based design studio **AMALA** to create visuals around their current live show. The band have been touring throughout 2016 in support of sophomore record *Infinite Summer*, playing headline shows in the UK and France, and most recently the Royal Festival Hall as part of Southbank's Meltdown Festival.

Released in January 2016 on Memphis Industries, *Infinite Summer* is a concept album detailing the imminent extinction of humanity at the hands of our dying Sun. It's the end of life as we know it. Yet, maybe it isn't all bad; before the flames engulf us, we can take a minute to enjoy the unrelenting heat and pristine blue skies of this far-future Earth - a funky apocalypse, if you will.



Musically, *Infinite Summer* is indebted to the dance-led grooves of French artists such as Sebastien Tellier and Daft Punk, whilst channelling the bombastic 80s pop of Scritti Politti and Prefab Sprout. Yet the album also makes a forceful nod towards classic science fiction, stemming from lead singer Michael Lovett's infatuation with the work of Stanislaw Lem, Arthur C Clarke, Isaac Asimov and JG Ballard, et al.

As such, *Infinite Summer* creates a world for the listener, one which demands a visual accompaniment. To bring the songs to life on-stage, NZCA LINES have been working closely with **TAXONYM** and **AMALA**, who have created cinematic live visuals inspired by the album's theme. The end result of this collaboration will be a production for NZCA LINES' **headline show at Village Underground on September 28th**, the band's biggest concert to date.

New contemporary arts space **Assembly Point** are excited to present an initial preview, and premiere, of this material.
